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**Do <u>not</u> come dressed in your costume!** Please wear your base layer (tights and dance bra) under something easy to change out of like shorts or a dress. Change at the competition venue in the dressing room. Please keep costume hung! All costumes have been steamed and we don't want them wrinkled in the car.

**COSTUMES**: Please carefully store your child's costume as they will use it again for the March competition, April CADT concert, and June annual recitals. DO NOT wash or dry the costumes. If they need cleaned, please speak with your child's teacher about the proper way to address this.

**COMPETITION HAIR**: Ponytail at the crown of the head with a ponytail holder that matches the dancer's hair color. Any clips or bobbie pins also need to match the dancer's hair color. We have these items available at the dance school for purchase. All loose hair is clipped and hair sprayed securely.

Boys: Hair must be styled to stay out of the face

Students will not be permitted to perform with hair dyed an unnatural color (i.e. pink, purple, orange, etc.) or visible tattoos. Please use make up designed to cover tattoos. Speak with the staff if you have any questions regarding this.

**HAIR ACCESSORIES:** <u>All hair accessories will NOT be sent home.</u> We have collected all hair accessories. DCSD staff will bring all hair accessories to competition and collect after performing.

**DANCE BRA:** Clear strap bra or dance bra (if needed) – no sports bras

**MAKEUP:** Please arrive with your hair and makeup done. Foundation, blush, mascara (waterproof), lipstick, and powder (not required but strongly suggested to set everything). **Makeup, including lipstick, are not to be applied in the lobby area.** When applying the eye shadow, apply the lighter color over the entire eyelid (up to the brow line) and apply the darker color on the eyelid (below the crease only). Dab a small amount of the lighter shadow on the inside corner of the eye (against the bridge of the nose).

**TIGHTS:** DE and DE II- Suntan footed tights\* (style #1008) / DE Teens- Black footed tights\* (style #1001) \*students must have new tights – no convertible tights

**SHOES:** Black slip-on jazz shoes – all shoes must be in good condition, no holes

No gum, nail polish, or jewelry including rings, watches, or earrings of any kind. Please leave all jewelry items at home. The dance school is not responsible for lost items.

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#### **IMPORTANT COMPETITION REMINDERS**

- Admission is FREE!
- The competition will be live streamed via <a href="https://www2.vipdance.com/schedules/428">https://www2.vipdance.com/schedules/428</a>. This link is only active during the time and date of the competition.
- Audience members are welcome to video and shoot non-flash photography while your dancers are performing. Professional footage will be available online within 1 week following the event.
- When everyone arrives, Miss Tammy will escort dancers to the dressing room to change into costume. After
  changing into costume, parents are to collect everything from their dancer(s). Please keep items organized
  throughout the day to expedite our departure. Do not leave anything in the dressing room. Parents are not
  permitted in the dressing room. No exceptions.
- After performing meet Miss Tammy off stage. Everyone will return to the auditorium together to finish
  watching the other dancers. If other studio dancers have yet to perform, please stay to cheer them on!
- When awards start, return to the stage and sit with your group. All dancers are to wear costumes and dance shoes for awards. As soon as awards are complete all performers are to meet with Miss Tammy for photos.
- Only enter and exit the auditorium between numbers and not during them. Even if you see others doing it!
   Please be respectful of all audience members and dancers.
- We **strongly** encourage all parents and dancers to show your support for our dancers through your thunderous applause before and after each piece.
- No food or drink is permitted in the auditorium or dressing rooms.
- Please remember to conduct yourself appropriately throughout the event. We ask that you refrain from
  commenting negatively regarding <u>ANYTHING</u>. Remember, the person sitting in front of you may be a family
  member or friend of the child on stage and the people beside and behind you may not hear you but they will
  see you whispering and we don't want their opinion of our dance school to be determined by their
  assumption of your topic.
- Please remind your child the results of this competition are the opinions of three individuals. The staff asks
  that you celebrate all the accomplishments of the performers whether they come in the form of a first
  place or not. Our only goal is that our dancers are prepared and have a positive experience and perform
  their personal best.
